

Technology Donation Minimum Requirements

The Pinconning Area School District is fortunate to have an extremely supportive community that is willing to give both their time and other tangible offerings for the benefit of the district. We deeply appreciate each of these gifts and encourage their continuation. Technology comprises a large part of the staff and students everyday routine and some of the inner-workings of the school would be severely crippled without it. As we progress into the future, technology is ever changing and our older equipment is quickly becoming out of date. The district will always welcome for review technology donations and due to the increased need for newer equipment we ask that the following minimum requirements be met. These minimum requirements will remain in effect during the period of the current Technology Plan (July 1, 2006 – June 30, 2009).

Windows:

1 GHz Pentium III processor or greater
256 MB of RAM or more
10 GB hard drive or larger
CD-ROM Drive
100Mb Ethernet Card
Sound Card
Video card and monitor the supports a resolution of at least 1024x768
Built in USB ports

Apple:

700 MHz G3 processor or greater
256 MB of RAM or more
10 GB hard drive or larger
CD-ROM drive
Sound Card
100 Mb Ethernet card
Firewire port

Printers:

The district has begun to standardize on HP Laserjet printers. In addition to the brand and model requirements, printers should also meet these minimum requirements:

Internal JetDirect Card
8 MB RAM or more
15 Pages Per Minute or faster
600 x 600 dpi or greater

In addition all computer donations should be fully functional and include a color monitor that meets the requirements of the video card, keyboard, mouse, and all necessary cables. All printers should have the necessary cords and paper trays. Printers will be accepted without toner cartridges however they must have all rollers and the fuser unit intact.
